- Demonstrate high moral character, spirit, and a strong commitment to his/her community.
- Download and complete the application form and email it along with all supporting materials to info@the67foundation.org no later than **March 15, 2016**. **All information must be received by this date.**

- Include one letter of recommendation from a teacher, guidance counselor, employer, or community leader
- Include copy of school attendance record**
- Scan and send all materials **in one message** to info@the67foundation.org
